Supervised and Supported Contact Centre

Safe and Structured Family Time: Our centre provides a welcoming and secure space for children to meet with their families. These sessions are designed to preserve family bonds, promote positive interactions, and ensure the safety of all participants.

Tailored Support: Each family's unique circumstances are taken into account, and we design sessions that align with the specific needs outlined in their care plans.





Community-Based Contact Services:

For families where appropriate, we offer contact sessions in community settings, helping children and parents build relationships in familiar, everyday environments. Sessions are carefully monitored and supported by trained staff to ensure that they meet the needs of the children and comply with agreed care plans.

Additional Support Activities: Therapeutic Techniques: Incorporating art, play, and other therapeutic approaches to facilitate communication and strengthen family relationships.

Parenting Guidance: Providing resources and advice to help parents better understand and meet their children's needs.

Skill Development: Activities designed to improve children's social skills, emotional well-being, and self-awareness.




